About CMF

The Canadian Mesothelioma Foundation (CMF) was founded in 2008 by people whose lives have been personally affected by mesothelioma, a rare form of cancer that is almost exclusively linked to asbestos exposure. Despite a dramatic decline in the use of asbestos since the early 1980s in Canada, the incidence of mesothelioma in Canada, and around the world, is on the rise because symptoms of the disease often do not present until decades after asbestos exposure.

A registered charity, the Foundation raises awareness about the link between mesothelioma and asbestos exposure and supports mesothelioma patients and their families, as well as the development of expertise in mesothelioma diagnosis, treatment and care across Canada.

We are largely volunteer-run with donations going directly towards achieving our mandate.



The CMF is committed to supporting the existing medical community and infrastructure in Canada for diagnosing and treating mesothelioma. Our objectives are to:

- Further collaboration and development of tertiary care specialists in mesothelioma diagnosis, treatment and care and leading edge clinical practice
- Increase awareness amongst health professionals of screening, early diagnosis, mesothelioma centres of excellence and other resources.

We do this through the provision of educational and training grants, educational workshops and conferences, and through the development of our Health Network.
